The bicentennial of the departure and arrival of the ABCFM missionaries to Hawai'i happens in the Fall of 2019. Henry 'Ōpūkaha'ia, the young Hawaiian who inspired the ABCFM mission, died on February 17, 1818, in Cornwall, CT. The Thaddeus sailed on October 23, 1819.
